CPSIs are certified to inspect playgrounds for safety issues, making sure that each playground that they inspect is up to the current national standards. The national standards are developed by the ASTM and CPSC. Candidates must be 18 years or older and have earned a high school diploma. No walk-ins allowed for class or exam.
